Terms and Conditions

Amici ("Amici Singles", "us", "we" and "its") simply organizes and hosts a variety of events for its members. A "host" is a member of Amici that has agreed to be host and/or be the contact for a given Amici event. Amici is a members' only events club. Non-members are not permitted to attend events unless it has been specifically declared as an open event or an event where the host allows non-members to attend. Amici does not have the ability to independently screen participants registering for its events and/or social gatherings. For example, Amici does not verify personal information provided by its participants, mailing list subscribers and web site users (hereinafter collectively referred to as its "users", "you" and "your") such as marital status, age, or any other aspects of their general background. It is up to you to confirm these issues to your own satisfaction.

By registering for an Amici event, you are agreeing that Amici is not liable for any damages, direct or indirect, that may in any way arise out of Amici's social gatherings. This includes, without limitation, damages arising out of meeting or communicating with other participants in programmes sponsored by or affiliated with Amici.

This is a legal agreement ("Agreement") between you and Amici. As part of your registration to become a member of Amici, you must confirm that you have read and understood the terms and conditions of this Agreement (the "Terms"). By registering to become a member of Amici (a "Member") you agree to be bound by the Terms of this Agreement for as long as you continue to be a Member. If you do not agree to the Terms, please do not register to become an Amici member. The terms are subject to change by Amici at any time, effective upon notice to you.

1. Eligibility

PERSONS UNDER 25 MAY NOT BECOME MEMBERS.

By becoming a Member, you represent and warrant that you are at least 25 years old. Participation in Amici events and use of Amici's web site are void where prohibited. By participating in Amici events and/or using Amici's web site, you represent and warrant that you have the right, authority, and capacity to enter into this Agreement and to abide by all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Your membership in Amici is for your sole, personal use. You may not authorize others to use your membership, and you may not assign or otherwise transfer your account to any other person or entity. You are responsible for logging out if your computer is accessible to others. This prevents unauthorized access to your account and registration information. Amici reserves the right to refuse membership to any prospective member.

2. Term

This Agreement will remain in full force and effect while you continue to be a Member of Amici. Either you or Amici may terminate your membership at any time, for any reason, without explanation, effective upon sending written notice to the other party. Amici reserves the right to immediately suspend or terminate your access to any Amici event, without notice, upon any breach of this Agreement by you which is brought to the attention of Amici. Amici reserves the right to terminate membership before the expiry date without refund. Amici reserves the right to refuse a refund to members who terminate their membership early. Amici reserves the right to expel a member should their actions be found to be against the principles of Amici, or they are found to be using Amici as a source for organising events for other organisations.

Amici membership will lapse upon failure to pay the renewal fee within 1 day of expected date; this may be adjusted at the sole discretion of Amici.

3. Special liability disclaimers and release

You hereby understand and acknowledge that by using Amici's web site and participating in Amici events that your e-mail address, first name and certain other profiling information that you provide will be provided to certain other participants. Amici has conducted no research on the backgrounds of any of its Members or the participants at its events. Amici does not screen the members registering for events offered by Amici in any way, and does not verify information provided by its members. Therefore, Amici is not liable for the accuracy of such information. You agree to release Amici from any liability and assume the full responsibility and risk with respect to any person you meet at an Amici event or through this web site. Amici will not be liable for any damages, direct, indirect, incidental and/or consequential, arising out of the use of this service and/or attendance at Amici events, including, without limitation, to damages arising out of communicating and/or meeting with other members of this service or participants at these events. Such damages include, without limitation, physical damages, bodily injury and or emotional distress. We strongly encourage you to take the same precautions you would take in meeting any new person in order to assure your safety.

You also understand and acknowledge that Amici events are held at venues over which Amici has no control. Therefore, in the event that you are injured or suffer damages in any regard at an Amici event, you agree to release Amici from any liability with respect thereto, unless such damages result directly from the actions of any employee or agent of Amici.

All participants in Amici events understand and acknowledge that Amici provides creative ways to meet new people. Amici is not a dating agency nor is its intention to find a partner for its members.

4. Indemnity by member:

Amici is not responsible or liable for errors or omissions of any kind. Furthermore, members agree to indemnify and hold harmless Amici, its officers, directors, consultants, hosts, agents, employees, partners, affiliates, licensees and subsidiaries from any and all losses, claims, damages, expenses (including reasonable fees, disbursements, and other charges of Counsel), actions, proceedings, liabilities or investigations (whether formal or informal), or threats thereof, based upon, relating to, or arising in connection with any and all of the services that Amici provides or claims to provide as well as communications or meetings that you arrange on your own volition and on your own time with others who have participated in one of Amici's Events.



Further, users agree not to initiate any claim whatever against Amici as a result of any of our social gatherings or other activities and users affirm that they take sole and complete responsibility for any and all actions that might occur during any meeting, communication or date.

You agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Amici, its partners, employees, agents and third parties, for any losses, costs, its officers, directors, shareholders, consultants, hosts, agents, employees, partners, affiliates, licensees and subsidiaries from any and all losses, claims, damages, expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees, disbursements, and other charges of Counsel), actions, proceedings, liabilities and expenses relating to or arising out of your use of the Amici service, including any breach by you of the terms of this Agreement.

5. Ownership, copyright and trademark notices

5.1 The content of this web site is the property of Amici. Amici is duly formed in and governed under the laws of the United Kingdom and is qualified to do business in the United Kingdom.

8.3 When at a bar/pub/restaurant don't feel obliged to buy or accept drinks. If accepting a drink from another member you need to make sure you return the favour.

8.4 If you have enjoyed the event make sure you tell the host and thank them for organising it. As well as being a nice gesture it encourages them to continue hosting events.

8.5 Respect the privacy of hosts and fellow members by not calling them any later than 9pm (unless previously arranged).

8.6 Members must not run events for private profit or enterprise.

9. Member disputes

You are solely responsible for your interactions with other participants in Amici events and/or Amici member hosted events. Amici reserves the right, but has no obligation, to monitor disputes between you and other participants. You must speak immediately to Amici or a committee member if you have any reservations about the conduct of another member.

All disputes will be resolved by the founders of Amici, and their decision is final. Appeals should be directed towards the founders, and if an injustice has

occurred, the appropriate action will be taken.

10. Governing law

This Agreement and its performances are governed by the laws of United Kingdom, without regard to its conflict of laws provisions. You consent and submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the United Kingdom in all matters arising out of your use of this site.

11. Modification

Amici may at any time modify these terms and conditions and your continued use of the site will be conditioned upon the terms and conditions in force at the time of your use.

12. Severability

These terms and conditions shall be deemed severable. In the event that any provision is determined to be unenforceable or invalid, such provision shall nonetheless be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, and such determination shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any other remaining provisions.

13. Privacy

Amici will keep confidential all information supplied by you to Amici, including credit card number(s), and shall use or disclose such information only for the purposes for which such information was collected, or as required by law. Amici will not give out your contact details to anyone without having obtained your permission first although obviously your contact details will have to go into the diary if you are hosting an event. This can be just your email address or phone number or both, which ever you prefer.

Where you elect to act as an event host your email address, firstname, plus a phone number will be provided via Amici's web site to serve as contact details.

You hereby agree to not divulge members' email addresses & telephone numbers to anyone outside of the club. Members' contact details are confidential and are to be used solely for contacting them with regard to Amici matters.

You hereby agree to not divulge details of Amici events to non-members - exceptions being a particular event where Amici has indicated that members are allowed to bring guests. Please be aware that you are responsible for the conduct of any guests you bring along to Amici events.

14. Assignment

You may not assign, convey, subcontract or delegate your rights, duties or obligations hereunder. Please contact info@amicisingles.co.uk with any questions regarding this Agreement.
